2019 - 2021 Product Manager (Product Owner)

As the company's client base gradually grew together with the new CEO we redesigned my role from being the direct manager of the software development team to a product focussed role with more client facing responsibilities.

In this new role I still drive the product's roadmap and as such I still interact with the development team on a frequent basis. The emphasis of my daily job however shifted from operational management to developing a strategy and vision for the future of the product and company.

To get started I set out a new product strategy with main focus on achieving a higher customer/user satisfaction, to align with the company strategy of achieving growth through cross selling within the current client base. This

differentiated from the previous strategy that was focused on getting new clients onboard and as a result led to adding a lot of features to land deals.

In line with this new strategy, we started with a rebuild of the admin portal to address admin users' wishes, but also enabling better metric tracking because of a new modern technology stack. A similar rebuild plan is outlined for the client side apps (iOS, Android and Web). This shall on top of achieving higher customer satisfaction through better UX and optimized flows, set the foundation for faster development as well as better product usage insights.

Naturally as the companies' sole product evangelist I have played an active role in supporting sales, marketing and customer success processes.

Software development manager

2015 - 2019 After a strategic shift from primarily outsourcing development resources to Ukraine to also hiring an in-house software development team. I *naturally* grew into the role as manager, taking on a much wider array of responsibilities.

> This meant that I was responsible for defining and managing the product roadmap as well as managing the team building that product. The development team at its peak consisted of a total of 14 individuals, co-located at the Dutch office in Amsterdam and full-time contractors working from Lviv, Ukraine.
